

MANIFESTO OF SUPPORT FOR THE CHARTER OF EMERGING HUMAN RIGHTS

The transformations that are taking place in our societies and international community due to the acceleration of processes of globalisation and the use of new technologies are producing certain challenges in the field of human rights.

The Emerging Human Rights arise precisely from this context, with the conviction that the whole of humanity, as a political community, has the right to assume control over its own destiny. Avoiding interstate logic, the Emerging Human Rights conceive of a new citizen participation in which emerging rights are understood as citizen rights, taking into account the principles, prerogatives and demands of the global civil society. However, it does not aim to repeal or change existing instruments for protecting and guaranteeing human rights, but to reinforce them.

Emerging Human Rights are all those rights which despite being formally recognised in other legal instruments, have come to be seen with indifference by states and the international system. For that reason, they need to be restated definitively. The Emerging Human Rights also include new rights that have arisen from new situations where protection is lacking created by the rapid transformations of our globalised societies.

Therefore, as members of the global civil society, we demand the recognition, protection and guarantee of the Emerging Human Rights included in this draft charter.
